CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CECIL A. WOLFER, Jr.

confirms the right to use the waters of ALDER CREEK, a tributary of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 5.7 ACRES, DOMESTIC USE FOR TWO FAMILIES AND LIVESTOCK.

The right has been perfected under Permit 45768. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 10, 1980. The right is limited to not more than 0.086 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND; BEING 0.071 CFS FOR IRRIGATION, 0.01 CFS FOR DOMESTIC USE, AND 0.005 CFS FOR LIVESTOCK, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 33, T 30 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 10 FEET SOUTH AND 1215 FEET EAST FROM THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 33.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4 0.1 ACRE
SE 1/4 NW 1/4 5.6 ACRES, DOMESTIC AND LIVESTOCK
SECTION 33
TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
