CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of WALTON LAKE SPRING, a tributary of WALTON LAKE, for the purpose of CAMPGROUND USE.

This right has been perfected under Permit 48861. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 11, 1981. This right is limited to 0.004 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 21, T 13 S, R 20 E, W.M.; 1930 FEET SOUTH AND 3290 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 21.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4
NE 1/4 NW 1/4
SECTION 21
TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 20 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
