CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DAVID AND NANCY CLIFFORD
380 CHAMPAGNE COURT
ROSEBURG, OREGON 97470

confirms the right to use the waters of CHAMPAGNE CREEK, a tributary of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 2.1 ACRES.

This right has been perfected under Permit 50224. The date of priority is AUGUST 6, 1987. This right is limited to 0.026 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 4 (SW 1/4 SE 1/4), SECTION 12, T 27 S, R 7 W, W.M.; 365 FEET NORTH AND 500 FEET EAST FROM THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 12.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. This right is limited during the period July 15 through September 30 of each year to the irrigation of a noncommercial garden not to exceed one-half acre. This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

LOT 4 (SW 1/4 SE 1/4) 2.1 ACRES
SECTION 12
TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
