CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED SPRING, a tributary of TUALATIN RIVER, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING IRRIGATION OF ONE-HALF ACRE NONCOMMERCIAL LAWN AND GARDEN.

This right was perfected under Permit 50380. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 24, 1987. This right is limited to 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. This right is limited during the period from July 31 through September 15 of each year to human consumption and livestock consumption by such animals as are essential to the proper sustenance of the family.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 25, T 1 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 1790 FEET NORTH AND 50 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 25.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4
SECTION 26
TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
