CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

EARL L. BUMGARNER

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 0.75 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 21406. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 28, 1952. This right is limited to 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 40, SECTION 5, T 30 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 750 FEET SOUTH AND 180 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF DLC 40.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4 0.75 ACRE
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 37
SECTION 5
TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 9, 1986, and together with certificates 61853 and 64856, supersedes certificate 23596, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
