confirms the right to use the waters of SLATE CREEK, a tributary of APPLGATE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 1.0 ACRE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 16, at page 523. The date of priority is 1908.

This right is limited to 0.016 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 10, T 37 S, R 7 W, W.M.; 443 FEET NORTH AND 299 FEET WEST FROM THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 10.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4 1.0 ACRE  
SECTION 10  
TOWNSHIP 37 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEBRUARY 18, 1988 and together with certificate 57533, supersedes certificate 32928, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
