CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO UNNAMED STREAMS, both tributaries of BLACK BEAR CREEK, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR TWO FAMILIES INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF LAWN AND NON-COMMERCIAL GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE EACH.

This right has been perfected under Permit 39332. The date of priority is AUGUST 5, 1974. This right is limited to 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND; being 0.005 cfs from each stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 35, T 34 S, R 8 W, W.M.; WEST STREAM - 400 FEET SOUTH AND 800 FEET EAST; EAST STREAM - 450 FEET SOUTH AND 880 FEET EAST, BOTH FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 35.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4
NW 1/4 NW 1/4
SECTION 35
TOWNSHIP 34 SOUTH, RANGE 8 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
