confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED SPRING, a tributary of THE SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, for the purpose of STOCK USE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 41795. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 24, 1977. The right is limited to not more than 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 13, T 30 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 90 FEET NORTH AND 1460 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 13.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4
SECTION 24
TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
