CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JANIS M. BRABHAM

confirms the right to use the waters of BRABHAM RESERVOIR, constructed under permit R-8312, a tributary of TUALATIN RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 4.2 ACRES AND LIVESTOCK.

The right has been perfected under Permit 46106. The date of priority is AUGUST 7, 1981. The right is limited to not more than 1.5 ACRE-FEET OF STORED WATER ONLY; BEING 1.4 AF FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.1 AF FOR LIVESTOCK, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 30, T 1 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 1500 FEET SOUTH AND 940 FEET EAST FROM THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4 4.2 ACRES AND LIVESTOCK
SECTION 30
TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
