and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Orecome Union County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 8, at page 1; that 1, of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1876 for Tract #1: 1908 for Tract.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed. Three acre feet per acre in any irrigation senson, diverted at a rate of not to exceed one-fortieth of a cubic foot per second per acre;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

- Tract #1: Fifteen (15) acres in the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NWNNE1), Twenty-two (22) acres in the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SW1NE1), Section Three (3), Township 3 South, Range 38 East of the Willamette Meridian, being a total of 37 acres.
- Tract #2: Eighteen (18) acres in the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SWANDA) and Twenty-five (25) acres in the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NWSDA) of Section Three (3), Township 3 South, Range 38 East of the Willamette Meridian, being a total of 43 acres.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
