CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That TURNER OLIVER

of Spokane, State of Washington has a right to the use of the waters of Grande Ronde River and Big Clear Creek for the purpose of Mining and Power;

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 8, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1870

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed Ten second feet for Power purposes; one hundred second feet for Mining purposes, each stream to be supplemental to the other for the furnishing of that amount of water.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Mining and power on what is known as Camp Carson Placer Mines, all located in Township 6 South, Range 36 East of the Willamette Meridian, and in Sections 4, 5, 9, 10, 15, 16, 21, 22 and 28.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
