CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WENGER BROS. 2205 105TH AVENUE, NE SALEM, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of BEAVER CREEK, a tributary of PUDDING RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 1.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 19437. The date of priority is JULY 11, 1949. This right is limited to 0.015 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 49, SECTION 17, T 7 S, R 1 W, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SECTION 18
TOWNSHIP 7 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 20108, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on October 31, 1990 cancelling a portion of said water right.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
