CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of LONEROCK CREEK, a tributary of the JOHN DAY RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 18.8 ACRES.

This right has been perfected under Permit 41464. The date of priority is JANUARY 31, 1977. This right is limited to 0.47 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

LOT 3 (NW 1/4 SW 1/4), SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 31, T 5 S, R 24 E, W.M.; DIVERSION NO. 3 - 960 FEET SOUTH AND 970 FEET EAST, DIVERSION NO. 2 - 1640 FEET SOUTH AND 1810 FEET EAST, DIVERSION NO. 1 - 2280 FEET SOUTH AND 1750 FEET EAST ALL FROM THE W 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 4.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 4.7 ACRES NW 1/4 SW 1/4 4.0 ACRES SW 1/4 SW 1/4 0.3 ACRE SE 1/4 SW 1/4 9.8 ACRES SECTION 31

TOWNSHIP 5 SOUTH, RANGE 24 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
