CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LEONARD D. SPRINGER
ROUTE 1, BOX 116B
RIDDLE, OREGON 97469

confirms the right to use the waters of ASH CREEK, a tributary of COW CREEK, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 1.0 ACRE.

This right has been perfected under Permit 45154. The date of priority is JULY 2, 1980. This right is limited to 0.013 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 63, SECTION 30, T 30 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 700 FEET SOUTH AND 610 FEET WEST FROM THE CENTER 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-SEVENTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 1.0 ACRE
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 63
SECTION 30
TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
