that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed Three agree feet per agree in any irrigation season, diverted at a rate of not to exceed one-fortieth of a cubic foot per second per agre;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Slocks 28 and 30, Sweckhamer's Second Addition to City of Union. (Being in the NW2SE2, Sec. 18, T. 4 S. R. 40 E.W.M.)

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
