CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DENVIL AND GENEVA KIMBLE 288 GAZELY BRIDGE ROAD MYRTLE CREEK, OREGON 97457

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 1.0 ACRE.

This right has been perfected under Permit 49707. The date of priority is JUNE 3, 1986. This right is limited to 0.013 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 50, SECTION 21, T 30 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 900 FEET NORTH AND 40 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 50
SECTION 21
TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

THIS RIGHT IS LIMITED TO IRRIGATION OF A NON-COMMERCIAL GARDEN NOT EXCEEDING ONE-HALF ACRE DURING THE PERIOD JULY 15 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30 OF EACH YEAR.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
