confirms the right to use the waters of BEAR CREEK, a tributary of MCKENZIE RIVER, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY.

The right has been perfected under Permit 8525. The date of priority is JUNE 11, 1928. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 32, T 16 S, R 3 E, W.M.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4
SECTION 32
TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 3 EAST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to correctly describe the place of use and supersedes certificate 9502 State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
