CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RICHARD E. HALLIBURTON

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of SEVENMILE SLOUGH, for the purpose of AIR TEMPERATURE CONTROL, HARVESTING CRANBERRIES, AND THE IRRIGATION OF 2.58 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 36440. The date of priority is AUGUST 9, 1971. This right is limited to 0.353 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.353 CFS FOR AIR TEMPERATURE CONTROL, 0.304 CFS FOR HARVESTING CRANBERRIES, AND 0.066 CFS FOR IRRIGATION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 3, T 28 S, R 14 W, W.M.; 2900 FEET SOUTH AND 2680 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 3.

The amount of water used for CRANBERRIES under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. If for the irrigation of any other crop, this appropriation is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by certificate 48783, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 19, 1990, approving transfer application T-6407 and supercedes certificate 48783.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
