CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

SCIO WATER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT ROUTE 3, BOX 273 SCIO, OREGON 97374

confirms the right to use the waters of THOMAS CREEK, a tributary of the SOUTH SANTIAM RIVER, for IRRIGATING 113.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 32841. The date of priority is AUGUST 16, 1967. This right is limited to 1.41 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 10, T 10 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 860 FEET NORTH AND 2640 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 10.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 40795, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 17, 1990, approving Transfer Application 6371.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
