confirms the right to use the waters of CALAPOOYA CREEK, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for the purpose of MANUFACTURING IN GRAVEL PLANT.

This right has been perfected under Permit 33215. The date of priority is JULY 23, 1968. This right is limited to 1.0 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 1, T 25 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 2450 FEET SOUTH AND 400 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 1.

This certificate is issued subject to the maintenance of adequate treatment facilities to remove the sediment before returning the water to the stream and provided that the total quantity appropriated under this certificate together with that appropriated under Certificate 39726 shall not exceed 1.0 cfs at any time.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4
SECTION 1
TOWNSHIP 25 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
