CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

EDWARD B. UFFELMAN

confirms the right to use the waters of MARKS CREEK, a tributary of the JOHN DAY RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 15.0 ACRES.

This right has been perfected under Permit 41361. The date of priority is JUNE 2, 1970 FOR 0.25 CFS AND MARCH 18, 1977 FOR 0.13 CFS. This right is limited to 0.38 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 12, T 13 S, R 27 E, W.M.; 860 FEET SOUTH AND 1000 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 12.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 5.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 13.6 ACRES  
SE 1/4 SW 1/4 0.7 ACRE  
SW 1/4 SE 1/4 0.7 ACRE  
SECTION 12  
TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 27 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
