CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of EAST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER, a tributary of ILLINOIS RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY AND THE IRRIGATION OF 0.2 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 39132. The date of priority is MARCH 19, 1974. This right is limited to 0.015 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND BEING 0.005 CFS FOR DOMESTIC USE AND 0.01 CFS FOR IRRIGATION or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 26, T 40 S, R 8 W, W.M.; 1625 FEET SOUTH AND 600 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER SECTION 26.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FIFTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4 0.2 ACRE AND DOMESTIC  
SECTION 26  
TOWNSHIP 40 SOUTH, RANGE 8 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
