confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED SPRING, a tributary of BEAR CREEK, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF LAWN AND NON COMMERCIAL GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE.

This right has been perfected under Permit 45896. The date of priority is APRIL 7, 1981. This right is limited to 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 27, T 28 S, R 14 W, W.M.; 580 FEET SOUTH AND 1140 FEET EAST FROM THE N 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 27.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4
SECTION 27
TOWNSHIP 28 SOUTH, RANGE 14 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
