## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CITY OF RIDDLE P.O. BOX 143 RIDDLE, OREGON 97469

confirms the right to use the waters of COW CREEK, a tributary of the SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, for the purpose of MUNICIPAL USE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 18084. The date of priority is DECEMBER 11, 1947. The right is limited to not more than 1.0 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 47, SECTION 24, T 30 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 2160 FEET SOUTH AND 2800 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 24.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

S 1/2 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 SECTION 13

E 1/2 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 SECTION 23

W 1/2 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 N 1/2 SW 1/4 SECTION 24

TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUNE 15, 1987 and supersedes certificate 20855, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
