confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the McKAY CREEK BASIN for the purpose of IRRIGATING 4.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-8590. The date of priority is MAY 16, 1979. This right is limited to 0.06 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 33, T 2 N, R 32 E, W.M.; 958 FEET SOUTH AND 51 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 33.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.
