CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GORDON H. JONES

confirms the right to use the waters of LITTLE APPLGATE RIVER, a tributary of APPLGATE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 1.0 ACRE. This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 1, 1857.

This right is limited to 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 13, T 39 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 1660 FEET NORTH AND 550 FEET EAST FROM THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 13.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4 1.0 ACRE
SECTION 13
TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCTOBER 21, 1988, and together with certificate 60559, supersedes certificate 16392, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
