CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of DESCHUTES RIVER, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 0.34 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 3438. The date of priority is JULY 19, 1917. This right is limited to 0.004 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 31, T 16 S, R 12 E, W.M.; 14 FEET SOUTH AND 1196 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 4.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 0.34 ACRE SECTION 31 TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered APRIL 13, 1990 and in part supersedes certificate 29926, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
