confirms the right to use the waters of the APPLGATE RIVER, a tributary of the ROGUE RIVER, for the purpose of the PRIMARY IRRIGATION OF 22.8 ACRES AND THE SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 3.7 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 3743. The date of priority is MARCH 25, 1918. The right is limited to not more than 0.331 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 39, SECTION 30, T 38 S, R 3 W, W.M.; KUBLI DITCH - 2510 FEET SOUTH AND 3370 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF DLC 39.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated from April 2 to October 31 of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by certificate 56324, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 10, 1991, approving transfer application T-5984.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
