CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CARL MCKENZIE 1995 NE 6TH GRANTS PASS, OREGON 97526

confirms the right to use the waters of SHAN CREEK, a tributary of the ROGUE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 0.4 ACRE.

This right has been perfected under Permit 38496. The date of priority is JULY 31, 1973. This right is limited to 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 11, T 36 S, R 7 W, W.M.; 1060 FEET SOUTH AND 1250 FEET EAST FROM THE W 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 11.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 4.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4 0.4 ACRE SECTION 11
TOWNSHIP 36 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
