CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

FRED W. KAUP ROUTE 1, BOX 52 JOSEPH, OREGON 97846

confirms the right to use the waters of WALLOWA RIVER, a tributary of GRANDE RONDE RIVER, for the purpose of PRIMARY IRRIGATION OR 3.0 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 23.8 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 41774. The date of priority is APRIL 29, 1977. The right is limited to not more than 0.67 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 31, T 2 S, R 45 E, W.M.; 550 FEET SOUTH AND 800 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER SECTION 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SUPPLEMENTAL 23.8 ACRES

SE 1/4 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 NE 1/4

SECTION 30

TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 45 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
