confirms the right to use the waters of BESTUL CREEK, a tributary of the NORTH FORK COQUILLE RIVER, for the purpose of DAIRY BARN AND STOCK USE.

This right has been perfected under Permit 42455. The date of priority is AUGUST 23, 1977. This right is limited to 0.015 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND BEING 0.01 CFS FOR DAIRY BARN USE AND 0.005 CFS FOR STOCK USE or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 15, T 28 S, R 12 W, W.M.; 5160 FEET NORTH AND 3350 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 15.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4 STOCK USE AND DAIRY BARN SW 1/4 NE 1/4 STOCK USE AND DAIRY BARN SECTION 15
TOWNSHIP 28 SOUTH, RANGE 12 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
