CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOHN R. BEAN, SR. AND DIANE G. BEAN HCR 88, BOX 274 BAKER CITY, OREGON 97814

confirms the right to use the waters of BIG CREEK, a tributary of the POWDER RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 3.8 ACRES.

This right has been perfected under Permit 45440. The date of priority is DECEMBER 1, 1980. This right is limited to 0.10 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 28, T 6 S, R 42 E, W.M.; BIG CREEK DITCH.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 3.8 ACRES SECTION 24
TOWNSHIP 7 SOUTH, RANGE 41 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
