CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of GRAVE CREEK, a tributary of ROGUE RIVER, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY.

The right has been perfected under Permit 47124. The date of priority is MARCH 11, 1982. The right is limited to not more than 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 6, T 34 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 2400 FEET NORTH AND 1800 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 6.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4
SECTION 6
TOWNSHIP 34 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
