CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of BEAR CREEK AND BEAR CREEK HATCHERY RESERVOIR, CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-10820, a tributary of SANDY RIVER, for the purpose of RAISING FISH.

This right has been perfected under Permit 49931. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 18, 1986. This right is limited to 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 26, T 1 S, R 4 E, W.M.; 560 FEET NORTH AND 2390 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 26.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4
SECTION 26
TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 4 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
