CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

THE CITY OF ROSEBURG
900 S.E. DOUGLAS STREET
ROSEBURG, OREGON 97470

confirms the right to use the waters of NEWTON CREEK AND STEWART PARK WILDLIFE POND, CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-2119, tributary of THE SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, for the purpose of RECREATION.

The right has been perfected under Permit 25405. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 3, 1957. The right is limited to not more than 0.10 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 65, SECTION 14,
T 27 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 850 FEET SOUTH AND 1350 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER,
SECTION 14.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4
NW 1/4 NE 1/4
BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 65
SECTION 14
TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
