CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RICHARD E. BROCK

confirms the right to use the waters of HURRICANE CREEK, a tributary of the WALLOWA RIVER, for the purpose of the SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 17.0 ACRES.

This right has been perfected under Permit 42207. The date of priority is MAY 20, 1977. This right is limited to 0.31 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 1, SECTION 3, T 3 S, R 44 E, E.M.; SOUTH 76 DEGREES 02 MINUTES WEST, 49 FEET FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 3.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The right shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4 17.0 ACRES  
SECTION 16  
TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 44 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
