confirms the right to use the waters of ALSEA RIVER, a tributary of PACIFIC OCEAN, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 39.5 ACRES.

This right has been perfected under Permit 40131. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 24, 1975. This right is limited to 0.49 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 3, WITHIN DLC 40, T 14 S, R 8 W, W.M.; 1480 FEET NORTH AND 670 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 3.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.
