CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

JOAN GISLER AND PHYLLIS POWELL 155 PILLER PLACE CAVE JUNCTION, OREGON 97523

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of WEST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 2.3 ACRES.

This right has been perfected under Permit 42217. The date of priority is MAY 23, 1977. This right is limited to 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 39, SECTION 32, T 39 S, R 8 W, W.M.; 4050 FEET SOUTH AND 110 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 32.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FIFTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 1.2 ACRES AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 39 SECTION 31

NW 1/4 SW 1/4 1.0 ACRE SW 1/4 SW 1/4 0.1 ACRE

AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 39

SECTION 32 TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 8 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
