CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GARY L. OWENS

confirms the right to use the waters of the YAMHILL RIVER, a tributary of the WILLAMETTE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 23.1 ACRES.

This right has been perfected under Permit 44208. The date of priority is MAY 10, 1979. This right is limited to 0.29 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 76, SECTION 11,
T 4 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 1400 FEET NORTH AND 2250 FEET EAST FROM THE SW
CORNER OF SECTION 11.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 5.6 ACRES
NW 1/4 NE 1/4 13.4 ACRES
SW 1/4 NE 1/4 3.9 ACRES
SE 1/4 NE 1/4 0.2 ACRE
ALL AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 76
SECTION 14
TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
