CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of APPLGATE RIVER AND APPLGATE LAKE RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-7810, a tributary of ROGUE RIVER, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY AND PRIMARY IRRIGATION OF 2.0 ACRES FROM APPLGATE RIVER AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 2.0 ACRES FROM APPLGATE LAKE RESERVOIR.

The right has been perfected under Permit 48302. The date of priority is OCTOBER 14, 1983 FOR 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND AND JANUARY 6, 1984 FOR 4.0 ACRE-FEET. The right is limited to not more than 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.005 CFS FOR DOMESTIC USE AND 0.025 CFS FOR IRRIGATION, AND 4.0 ACRE FEET STORED WATER FROM APPLGATE LAKE RESERVOIR FOR SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 5, T 37 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 750 FEET NORTH AND 1225 FEET EAST FROM THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 5. APPLGATE DAM - S 1/2 SE 1/4, SECTION 25, T 40 S, R 4 W, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre from direct flow, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage.

The right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein. The right is also subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 4-07-10-W0512 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4 2.0 ACRES AND DOMESTIC
SECTION 5
TOWNSHIP 37 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
