The right has been perfected under Permit 49590. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 18, 1985. The right is limited to not more than 0.05 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 38, SECTION 21, T 29 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 990 FEET SOUTH AND 570 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 21.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 38
SECTION 21
TOWNSHIP 29 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

THIS APPROPRIATION SHALL BE LIMITED TO THE PERIOD OCTOBER 1 THROUGH JULY 14 OF EACH YEAR.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
