CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

TOM DE ARMOND
11463 BROADACRES ROAD, NE
HUBBARD, OREGON 97302

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the MILL CREEK BASIN for IRRIGATING 26.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-5567. The date of priority is MAY 23, 1972. This right is limited to 0.24 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

LOT 2 (SW 1/4 SE 1/4), SECTION 29, T 4 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 370 FEET NORTH AND 2750 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 29.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 3.0 ACRES
NW 1/4 SE 1/4 22.6 ACRES
SW 1/4 SE 1/4 1.3 ACRES
ALL AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 58
SECTION 29
TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 45551, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 28, 1991, approving Transfer Application 6438.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
