This right was perfected under Permit G-10953. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 15, 1983. This right is limited to not more than 0.09 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
