CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WEYERHAEUSER COMPANY

confirms the right to use the waters of MILLER CREEK, a tributary of BEAVER MARSH, for the purpose of FILLING TRUCKS FOR ROAD MAINTENANCE.

This right has been perfected under Permit 38321. The date of priority is JANUARY 29, 1974. This right is limited to 40,000 GALLONS PER DAY or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 12, T 28 S, R 7 E, W.M.; 231 FEET NORTH AND 1148 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 12.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4
SECTION 12
TOWNSHIP 28 SOUTH, RANGE 7 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
