CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of SALMON RIVER, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE AT 15 CAMPSITES IN GREEN CANYON CAMPGROUND.

The right has been perfected under Permit 48718. The date of priority is AUGUST 12, 1981. The right is limited to not more than 0.11 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 27, T 3 S, R 7 E, W. M.; 1800 FEET NORTH AND 820 FEET EAST FROM SOUTHWEST CORNER SECTION 27.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4
NE 1/4 SE 1/4
SECTION 28
TOWNSHIP 3 SOUTH, RANGE 7 EAST, W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
