confirms the right to use the waters of "K" SPRING, a tributary of INDIAN CREEK, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR CAMPGROUND AND DAY USE PICNIC AREA.

The right has been perfected under Permit 48722. The date of priority is OCTOBER 6, 1981. The right is limited to not more than 0.001 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

BEAR SPRINGS DISTRICT  
SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 22, T 5 S, R 10 E, W.M.; 1815 SOUTH  
AND 1155 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER SECTION 22.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4  
SW 1/4 SE 1/4  
SE 1/4 SE 1/4  
SECTION 22  
TOWNSHIP 5 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
