CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of ELKHORN SPRING, a tributary of REAM POND, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE BY CAMPERS AT ELKHORN CAMPGROUND.

The right has been perfected under Permit 48677. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 11, 1981. The right is limited to not more than 0.0022 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 22, T 17 S, R 20 E, W.M.; 1430 FEET NORTH AND 2860 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 22.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4
SECTION 22
TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 20 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
