CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ALFRED W. FABER

confirms the right to use the waters of FAIRY CREEK, (AKA FERRY CREEK) a tributary of the COQUILLE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 10.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 16260. The date of priority is MAY 14, 1945. The right is limited to 0.344 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 33, T 28 S, R 14 W, W.M.; 1250 FEET
NORTH AND 1690 FEET EAST FROM THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 33.

The amount of water used for irrigation of CRANBERRIES under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-TENTH of one cubic foot per second per acre (or its equivalent) and a diversion of not to exceed 0.75 acre-foot per acre in any 30 day period and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 6.0 acre-feet per acre during the irrigation season of each year. The amount of water used for irrigation of any other crop is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4 8.3 ACRES
NE 1/4 NW 1/4 2.1 ACRES
SECTION 33
TOWNSHIP 28 SOUTH, RANGE 14 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by certificate 21431, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 8, 1991, approving transfer application 6163.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
