CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of A SPRING, a tributary of DOERNER CREEK, for the purpose of STOCK WATER, FISH CULTURE AND IRRIGATING 2.1 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 44767. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 29, 1979. The right is limited to not more than 0.04 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND BEING 0.005 CFS FOR STOCK, 0.005 CFS FOR FISH, AND 0.03 CFS FOR IRRIGATION or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 40, SECTION 10, T 27 S, R 7 W, W.M.; 330 FEET SOUTH AND 240 FEET EAST FROM C 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 10.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4 STOCK WATER, FISH CULTURE, 2.1 ACRES
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 40
SECTION 10
TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
