CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of CEDAR FORK CREEK, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY.

This right has been perfected under Permit 46661. The date of priority is DECEMBER 14, 1981. This right is limited to 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 16, T 35 S, R 14 W, W.M.; 2170 FEET NORTH AND 870 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 16.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4
SECTION 16
TOWNSHIP 35 SOUTH, RANGE 14 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
